CARLOW COUNTY.

Carlow, an inland county in Leinster province. Boundaries: N., Kildare and Wicklow; E., Wicklow and Wexford; S., Wexford; W., Kilkenny and Queen's. Greatest length, N. and S., 29 miles; greatest breadth, E. and W., 204; comprising an area of 346 square miles, or 221,342 acres, of which 184,059 are arable, 31,249 uncultivated, 4,927 in plantations, 602 in towns, and 505 under water. The Slaney flows through the county; the Barrow skirts it on the W. The population in 1841 was 86,228; 72,172 in the rural, and 14,056 in the civic district. The county is divided into 7 baronies—Carlow, Forth, Idrone E. and W., Rathvilly, and St. Mullin's Lower and Upper. It is in Leighlin diocese. The county returns 3 members to Parliament; 2 for the county at large, constituency, 2,063; and 1 for Carlow borough, constituency, 618. The Assizes are held at Carlow, where are the County Prison, County Infirmary, and District Lunatic Asylum, to which the county is entitled to send 42 patients. Quarter Sessions are held at Carlow, Tullow, and Bagenalstown; Petty Sessions in 6 places. Fever Hospitals at Bagenalstown, Borris, Carlow, and Tullow. There are 11 Dispensaries in the county.
